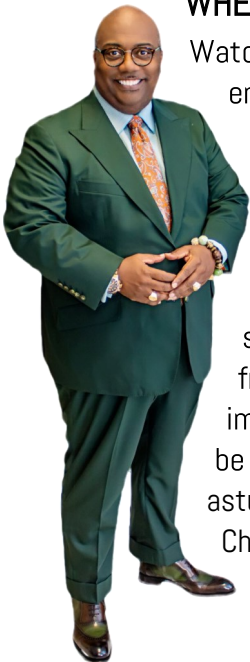
SCRIPTURE: *John 16:33*

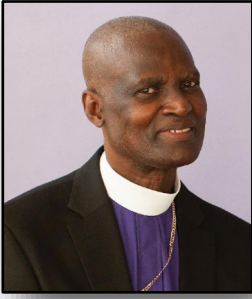

the heathen for your inheritance." America needs a revival. Our nation needs an outpouring. "If MY PEOPLE who are called by My name will humble themselves and pray. . ."

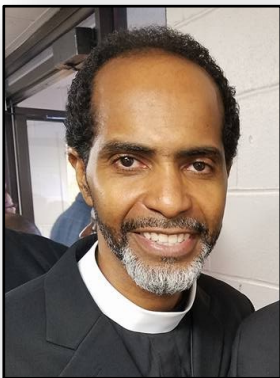

I Thessalonians 5:16-18
