# Greetings and God Bless You in this Holy Season of Lent!

What an amazing ninety-days of Awareness Sanctification with a ministry focus on OTHERS! This season of worship, work, sacrifice and benevolence in so many spaces has been our lenten fast.

What is Lent? Lent is a significant 40-day period in the Christian liturgical calendar that begins on Ash Wednesday and ends on Holy Saturday, the day before Easter Sunday. During this time, many Christians engage in fasting, prayer, and acts of selfdenial to commemorate Jesus Christ's 40day fast in the wilderness and his subsequent death and resurrection. The number 40 holds biblical significance, mirroring not only Jesus' time in the desert but also the 40 days of the Great Flood and the Israelites' 40 years in the wilderness. Traditional Lenten practices include giving up certain foods or luxuries, increasing prayer and charitable giving, and focusing on spiritual reflection and repentance. The period excludes Sundays in its count, as these are considered "mini-Easters" celebrating Christ's resurrection.

As we focus on our journey to Calvary to reflect on the journey of our Lord, let us prepare to celebrate the Resurrection of Christ! Our Holy Week 2025 schedule will include our sacred presentation of the Passover Meal (Seder) for our young adults and JGP 6-12 grades as we continue to mentor them in discipleship. We will observe our Maundy Thursday Sacramental Service with Holv Communion, Feet Washing and Water Baptism. Good Friday (day) we will celebrate with New Birth Church in Stonecrest, Georgia and celebrate Conversations Around the Cross in the evening in our sanctuary. We'll culminate our journey to Resurrection on Sunday at 8am, 9:30am and 11am services and children celebrations!

We are trusting God to be a blessing to our Music Ministry on Resurrection Sunday with a Super Seed Gift that will provide needed funding for our first Voices of Greater LIVE MUSICAL RECORDING!

God has blessed us to be a blessing and we are partnering with God for the benefit and blessing of OTHERS as we bring kingdom to community!
